We would like for you to spend some time with us.

Our riding camp program includes two riding sessions and one lecture daily, instruction in stable management and horse management, and leisure time activities. Riding programs are individually designed to meet the needs of each rider. Camps are scheduled in increments of one week.

The first weekly session will start May 24th. The week begins with arrival Monday morning (7:30-8:00 am) with orientation at 8 a.m. Students may bring their own horse or ride a school horse. The week ends on Saturday morning with a competition for all the campers of the week. Parents and friends are welcome. The last session of the summer will be the week of July 19th. (Please note that the weeks of June 21st and 28th are **reserved** for advance camp only.)

Fees are \$395/week for riding and instruction, \$250/week for room and board, and \$100/week for livery if the camper brings own horse. All fees are payable in advance - 50% with application and 50% upon arrival. Because space is limited, fees are non-refundable. Please do not hesitate to call if you need more information.

Space is limited. Camp registration begins February 23rd with a special time set aside for accepting registrations between 8 and 11 a.m. Because of limited space and the scheduling required, date changes can not be accepted after registration, nor refunds made for cancellations.

2010 Summer Camp Code of Conduct

Curragh Equestrian Center expects appropriate behavior from all summer campers.

Inappropriate behavior is:

- ◆ Profanity, vulgar language or gestures
- ◆ Assault
- ◆ Possession, use, or distribution of any illegal drugs or alcohol
- ◆ Harassment- using words or actions that intimidate, threaten or persecute others
- ◆ Abusing a horse, Curragh equipment or property
- ◆ Disrespect for other campers, Curragh employees or camp councilors

Any camper not conforming to the Code of Conduct may be expelled from camp. In this case parents will be called and asked to pick up the child; no refund of camp fees will be made.

Other information:

- ◆ Camper's cell phones are not to be used in the barn during the day, or during any evening activities!
- ◆ The campers will be learning by participating in the caring of horses, including tacking, grooming, bathing and feeding.
- ◆ Respect for the councilors and other campers is an important part of working together. My child understands they will be asked to be respectful during their time at camp.
- ◆ Each week we serve a set menu. Our councilors are unable to cook a special meal for any camp. Please make sure your child understands this policy and will eat the following:

Breakfast

- cereals
- fresh fruit
- juice/milk
- waffles

Lunch

- sandwiches
- macaroni and cheese
- burritos
- fruit

Dinner

- lasagna, salad, bread
- spaghetti, salad, bread
- chicken enchiladas, salad, tortilla chips
- chicken, vegetables, salad, bread
- Pizza

Fresh fruit and salad is always available
